Purpose/ Application	To identify the appropriate worksheets to use to submit a claim for organ acquisition costs.
Scope	Applies to Medicare Advantage plans only.
Policy	<p>Any claim submitted by a certified transplant center (CTC) which contains organ acquisition costs must be accompanied by form CMS-2552-10, Worksheet D4, Parts I-IV: V Computation of Organ Acquisition Costs and Charges for Hospitals Which Are Certified Transplant Centers detailing such costs .</p> <p>The form and instructions on how to complete the form can be found in the links in the "REFERENCES" section below.</p> <p>The Plan will pay the allowed costs for the organ acquisition as substantiated in the Cost Report.</p> <p>Any facility claim that is billed for organ acquisition costs which are not accompanied by form CMS-2552-10, Worksheets I-IV will be denied as an incomplete claim submission.</p>

Violations of Policy	<p>Violations of this policy by any party that enters into a written arrangement with the Plan may result in increased auditing and monitoring, performance guarantee contractual penalties and/or termination of the contract. Disciplinary actions will be determined at the Plan's sole discretion.</p> <p>Violations of this policy may be grounds for corrective action, up to and including termination of employment.</p>
Exceptions	Acquisition costs of Kidneys are excluded from reimbursement.
